Students Entering the Building Each School Day

- Each school principal will assign staff members, on a monthly calendar basis to check student temperatures before entering the school building.
 - **ALL STUDENTS** will be encouraged to wear masks. Children in grades 3rd-12th will be **REQUIRED** to wear masks. Students on the bus will wear a mask and/or prior to getting out of the vehicle. Students refusing to wear masks in grades 3rd-12th will be sent home, unless deemed medically unstable to wear a mask per school nurse health care plan and/or physician orders.
 - Staff responsible for temperature checks **CANNOT** be the School Nurse or the staff member designated to help cover the isolation room/area for that day. The School Nurse will be caring for regular needs during this time such as diabetic care and morning medication pass. The person in charge of the isolation room, should be readily available to monitor students if needed.
 - Staff members who are checking temperatures will be wearing face masks, face coverings, and gloves. Thermometers that will be used are non-contact style.
 - Students must maintain proper social distancing (6ft apart) while waiting to enter the school building.
 - Parent drop off and bus drop off should be in two different entrances, if possible. One set of staff members will check bus students' temperatures, and one set of staff members will check parent drop off students' temperatures. The principal will decide on the number of staff needed for each student drop off area.
 - Parents who drop off their child can expect their child's temperature to be taken before the child exits the vehicle, or immediately upon exiting the vehicle by a staff member. If the student has a temperature of **100** or higher the student must go back home with the parent and **NOT** enter the school building.

- Students who ride the bus will have their temperature checked before entering the building. If a student has a temperature of **100** or higher a mask will be placed on the student immediately regardless of age or grade, and the student will be taken to the isolation area/room. The parent/guardian will be called to pick up the student immediately.
