

**LOGAN COUNTY SCHOOLS  
 COVID-19 RESPONSE  
 FLOW OF ACTIONS  
 STUDENT BLUE  
 (Revised 3-3-21)**

Student has been in direct contact with a person, who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Student was NOT exposed at school or while performing extracurricular activities or school-based sports.

Student was exposed while at school or while performing extracurricular activities or school-based sports.

Parent or Legal Guardian will notify the school-based nurse or school administration of student's exposure.

School-based nurse will determine if student has already been placed on mandatory 10-day quarantine.

School-based nurse will collaborate with lead nurse and place student on immediate quarantine under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department.

If student has not been placed on mandatory 10-day quarantine, the school-based nurse will collaborate with the lead nurse and the Logan County Health Department for further instructions.

Student will be placed on a 10-day quarantine and advised to be COVID-19 tested per CDC guidelines and follow up with their primary doctor.

If advised by the Logan County Health Department, the school-based nurse and lead nurse will collaborate with school administration and place student on 10-day quarantine from date of last contact with positive case.

Regardless if the close contact student tests negative within their quarantine period; they must continue to stay on quarantine until the 10-day period is complete, and they are officially released from quarantine.

The school-based nurse may release students from quarantine under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department.

If the parent or guardian chooses to take their child/student to be tested for COVID-19 and the student tests positive, revert to RED Action Plan for Students

If student develops COVID-19 symptoms-revert to ORANGE Action Plan for Students

The school-based nurse or lead nurse will follow up with the positive student on an as needed basis.
