COVID-19 RESPONSE  
FLOW OF ACTIONS

Student has COVID-19 symptoms.  
Students who are sick should not attend school in-person.

Students should not attend school if they have the following symptoms:

- One of these: new onset cough or shortness of breath, fever (100°F or higher), diarrhea, or vomiting.
- At least two of the following: chills, muscle pain, sore throat, fatigue, congestion, loss of sense of smell or taste, or nausea.

Parent or Guardian will notify the school administration or school-based nurse of student absence due to COVID-19 symptoms.

If a student is absent due to COVID-19 symptoms, a signed doctor's note will be required for the student to return to school.



Student develops COVID-19 like symptoms while at school.

The teacher or staff member will alert the school-based nurse or administration that they have a student in their classroom who has reported COVID-19 symptoms.

Student will be placed in isolation area/room if the following criteria are met:

- One of these: new onset cough or shortness of breath, fever (100°F or higher), diarrhea, or vomiting.
- At least two of the following: chills, muscle pain, sore throat, fatigue, congestion, loss of sense of smell or taste, or nausea.

While in the isolation area/room the student will be monitored until parent or guardian arrives.

Parent or guardian will be notified of student's condition and be required to pick student up immediately.

The staff member monitoring the student will verify who is picking up the student, and upon arrival will walk the student out to appropriate parent or guardian.

If parent or guardian has not been successfully contacted within 1 hour of the student being placed in the isolation room/area, then the student will be transported to the local hospital via EMS. A staff member from the school will accompany the student to the local hospital as the student's representative until a parent or guardian arrives. The cost of the ambulance and hospital visit will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian. It is important to list several contact names and phone numbers on your child's emergency contact sheet. Any responsible adult listed on your child's emergency contact sheet may be notified in the event the school cannot reach the primary parent or guardian.

If a student is sent home with COVID-19 symptoms, a signed doctor's note will be required for the student to return to school.
