COVID-19 RESPONSE
FLOW OF ACTIONS

Student tests positive for COVID-19.

School administrator or school-based nurse will be notified by student/parent or guardian, or Logan County Health Department.

School-based nurse will collaborate with lead nurse and place student on immediate quarantine under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department.

School-based nurse will collaborate with the student and family, appropriate teachers, and administration to gather direct contact names within Logan County School System.

Under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department, the school nurse and school administration will notify all students and staff members deemed to have been close contacts.

Student with a positive test result will be placed on a minimum 10-day quarantine according to CDC and Logan County Health Department guidelines.

Contact tracing will be conducted regarding direct contacts to positive student.

“Classification of an individual as a close contact is based on many factors and should be assessed on a case-by-case basis” (CDC.gov, Interim Guidance for Case Investigation and Contact Tracing in K-12 Schools, 2020).

The school-based nurse or lead nurse will follow up with the positive student on an as needed basis.

The school-based nurse may release student from quarantine under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department.

Each individual case will be handled under the direct guidance of the Logan County Health Department, in collaboration with the school-based nurse, lead nurse, and school administration.
