COVID-19 RESPONSE FLOW OF ACTIONS
STUDENT BLUE

Student has been in direct contact with a person, who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Student was NOT exposed at school or while performing extracurricular activities or school-based sports.	Student was exposed while at school or while performing extracurricular activities or school-based sports.
Parent or Legal Guardian will notify the school-based nurse or school administration of student's exposure. Student will follow recommendations from Logan County Health Department.	School-based nurse will collaborate with lead nurse and all quarantine dates will be issued under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department. <u>*If a student has a member in their household that is positive, the students quarantine date will not begin until after the positive person's quarantine end date, unless the student can safely distance themselves from the positive case within the household.</u>
The close contact definition EXCLUDES students/staff who were within 3 to 6 feet of an infected individual <u>where both parties are wearing masks.</u> If both individuals (positive case and contact) were wearing masks, the contact will not be required to quarantine, but will self-monitor for symptoms for 14 days and continue to wear a mask for 14 days	Fully Vaccinated Student <u>No quarantine required</u> , Self-monitoring and mask required for 14 days while inside the school. <i>However, fully vaccinated people should get tested 3-5 days after their exposure, even if they don't have symptoms and wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure or until their test result is negative. (Per CDC and Health Department guidelines)</i> Unvaccinated Student has 2 options: <u>Option 1</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student can test after day 5, pending negative result they can be released on day 8. <u>Option 2</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student will quarantine for 10 days and be released on day 11.

The school-based nurse may release students from quarantine **ONLY** under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department.

If the parent or guardian chooses to take their child/student to be tested for COVID-19 and the student tests positive, revert to RED Action Plan for Students.

If student develops COVID-19 symptoms-revert to ORANGE Action Plan for Students.

The school-based nurse or lead nurse will follow up with the positive student on an as needed basis.

****Direct Contact is defined as any person who has been within 3-6 feet of a positive exposure case for an accumulative of 15 mins or longer****

Student has COVID-19 symptoms. *Students who are sick should not attend school in-person.*

If a student is absent due to COVID-19 symptoms, a signed doctor's note will be required for the student to return to school.

If a child has a pending COVID test, Student must have results prior to returning to school.

Student develops COVID-19 like symptoms while at school.



The teacher or staff member will alert the school-based nurse or administration that they have a student in their classroom who has reported COVID-19 symptoms.

Student will be placed in isolation area/room pending nursing assessment.

While in the isolation area/room the student will be monitored until parent or guardian arrives.

Parent or guardian will be notified of student's condition and be required to pick student up immediately.

If parent or guardian has not been successfully contacted within 1 hour of the student being placed in the isolation room/area, then the student will be transported to the local hospital via EMS. A staff member (**someone other than the school nurse**) will accompany the student to the local hospital as the student's representative until a parent or guardian arrives. The cost of the ambulance and hospital visit will be the responsibility of the parent or guardian. It is important to list several contact names and phone numbers on your child's emergency contact sheet. Any responsible adult listed on your child's emergency contact sheet may be notified in the event the school cannot reach the primary parent or guardian.

If a student is sent home with COVID-19 symptoms, a signed doctor's note will be required for the student to return to school.

Student tests positive for COVID-19.

School administrator or school-based nurse will be notified by student/parent or guardian, or Logan County Health Department.

School-based nurse will collaborate with lead nurse and place student on immediate quarantine for a minimum of 10 days under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department.

School-based nurse will collaborate with the student and family, appropriate teachers, and administration to gather direct contact names within Logan County School System.

Under the guidance of the Logan County Health Department, the school nurse and school administration will notify all students and staff members deemed to have been close contacts.

Contact tracing will be conducted regarding direct contacts to positive student under the direct guidance of Logan County Health Department.

The school-based nurse or lead nurse will follow up with the positive student on an as needed basis.

*** Each individual case will be handled under the direct guidance of the Logan County Health Department, in collaboration with the school-based nurse, lead nurse, and school administration. ***
